Scholarship Information

As college tuition continues to rise, the need to pursue scholarships is as important as it has ever been. Most scholarship applications are due in the spring, however, there are a few major scholarships that have earlier deadlines.

Boettcher Fund Scholarship: The Boettcher Scholarship is a merit-based scholarship, however it does not have specific academic eligibility criteria. See me ASAP if you are interested in applying for the Boettcher Scholarship. Application for the Boettcher Scholarship is done online at www.boettcherfoundation.org and closes on November 1st, 2020.

Daniels Fund Scholarship: The Daniels Fund Scholarship is a need-based scholarship available to Colorado residents. There is a selection process for the scholarship and application opens October 1st and closes on November 15th at 4:00pm. Please come by my office or visit www.danielsfund.org for more information.

Hurliman Scholarship: The Hurliman Scholarship is a merit-based scholarship available for students in Fremont, Custer, and Pueblo counties. A minimum GPA of 3.5 and an SAT score of 1150 or ACT score of 23 are required to apply for this scholarship. Application opens on October 1st and must be postmarked by February 1, 2021. Hagan Scholarship: Nationwide need-based merit scholarship for rural students. Approximately 40% of applicants receive this scholarship intended to help students graduate debt-free. Deadline November 15, 2020. Go to www.hsfmo.org for more information or see Mr. Bomgardner.
